Caught between her father's sermons, Ricky's promises, and the encroaching military, Claudia must navigate a tightrope of impossible choices. Both a slow burning crime thriller and western, Hostile Border follows the transformative journey of a young woman confronting the high price of American ideals in the dark places between two cultures.

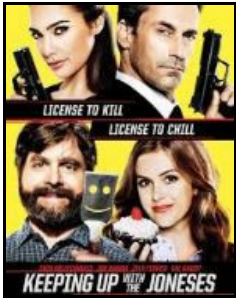
6/ It had to be you

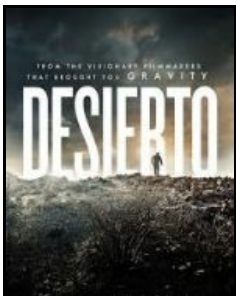
7/ Keeping up with the Joneses

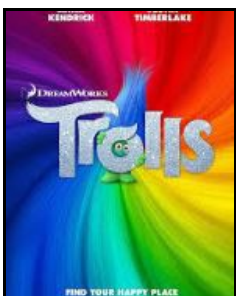
8/ Disierto
