**Starring:** Amandla Stenberg, Nick Robinson, Anika Noni Rose

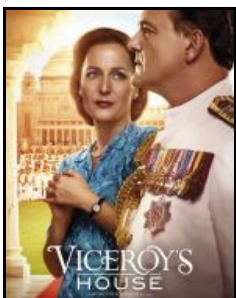
**Runtime:** 96 min.
