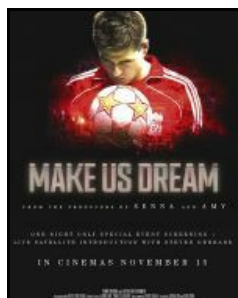
### 2/ The Hummingbird Project

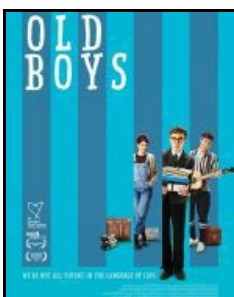
